

SABBATH INFORMATION

Kindly maintain reverence and decorum in the Main Auditorium. Although it is a gymnasium, during camp meeting it is our designated sanctuary and place of worship.

Special Seating: Lawn chairs are not permitted during the Friday evening through Sabbath evening meetings to help maximize seating. Those with special needs will be granted exceptions by permit at Information. During the week, designated areas will be provided for the smaller style lawn chairs without permit. For all meetings, space will be designated for wheelchairs and other special needs.

Saving Seats: Feel free to save seats *until song service begins*. When the singing starts, any unoccupied seat is free to be used by anyone. Refrain from using seat cushions to reserve seats.

Avoid sitting in seats that are reserved by signs for tram drivers, singers, speakers, official photographers, ushers, etc.

After each meeting, ushers will straighten up in preparation for the next service. Anything left behind, including seat cushions, will be removed and taken to Information.

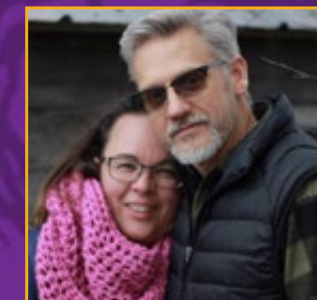
